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

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## INTRODUCTION

This publication is thirteenth in the population update series based on South Dakota's 1980 population. The tables in this report have been assembled to provide a convenient source of population information for the counties and incorporated places of South Dakota. The basic data have been taken from the U.S. Bureau of the Census, 1980 Census of Population - South Dakota PC80-1-A43 and the 1960 Census of Population-South Dakota PC(1)-43A. The figures are final population counts from the various census.

Table 1 lists South Dakota Counties by alphabetical order and the population of each county for the years 1950, 1960, 1970, and 1980. The last three columns list the percent change in each county's population between the years 1950 and 1960, 1960 and 1970, and 1970 and 1980. NOTE: The asterisk (\*) on Jackson County indicates that it was combined with Washabaugh County for the 1980 census. For comparison purposes, the 1950, 1960, and 1970 population counts for Washabaugh county have been added to those of Jackson County. This note applies also to Tables 2 and 3.

Table 2 lists South Dakota Counties ranked by population size for each county as of 1980. The population and rank for each county is listed for the years 1950, 1960, 1970, and 1980.

Table 3 lists South Dakota counties ranked by percent change between 1970 and 1980. The percent change and rank for each county is included for 1950 to 1960, 1960 to 1970, and 1970 to 1980.

Table 4 lists South Dakota Incorporated Places and Census Designated Places by alphabetical order along with their total population counts for the years 1950, 1960, 1970, and 1980. The last three columns list the percent change in population between 1950 and 1960, 1960 and 1970, and 1970 and 1980. The county in which each Incorporated Place or Census Designated Place is located is also listed. "NA" indicates that census data was not available for a particular place on a given year.

Table 5 lists South Dakota Incorporated Places and Census Designated Places by population size for the years 1950, 1960, 1970, and 1980. "NA" indicates that census data was not available for a particular place on a given year.

Table 6 lists South Dakota Incorporated Places and Census Designated Places by percent change between the years 1950 and 1960, 1960 and 1970, and 1970 and 1980. "NA" indicates that census data was not available for a particular Incorporated Place or Census Designated Place for one or more years. As a result, the percent change could not be calculated.

Table 7 lists South Dakota Incorporated Places and Census Designated Places alphabetically by county. Buffalo County was not included because it has no Incorporated Places or Census Designated Places. Populations for the years 1960, 1970, and 1980 are listed for each place along with the percent changes between 1960 and 1970 and between 1970 and 1980.

## DEFINITIONS

Incorporated Places are those places which are incorporated under the laws of the State of South Dakota as cities, boroughs, towns, and villages. The U.S. Bureau of Census reported 304 Incorporated Places in South Dakota in the 1980 census. Between 1970 and 1980, five places were incorporated and reported: Brandon (Minnehaha County), Crooks (Minnehaha County), Keystone (Pennington County), Warner (Brown County), and Westport (Brown County). No places which were incorporated prior to 1970 became unincorporated between 1970 and 1980.

Census Designated Places (CDP) are those closely settled population centers without corporate limits for which the U.S. Bureau of the Census delineated boundaries in the 1950, 1960, 1970, and 1980 censuses. In the 1980 census, these places have been identified as CDPs. In the 1950, 1960, and 1970 censuses, these places have been identified as Unincorporated Places (UP). South Dakota has six CDPs. Two of these have come in to being since 1970: Rapid Valley (Pennington County) and Blackhawk (Meade County).

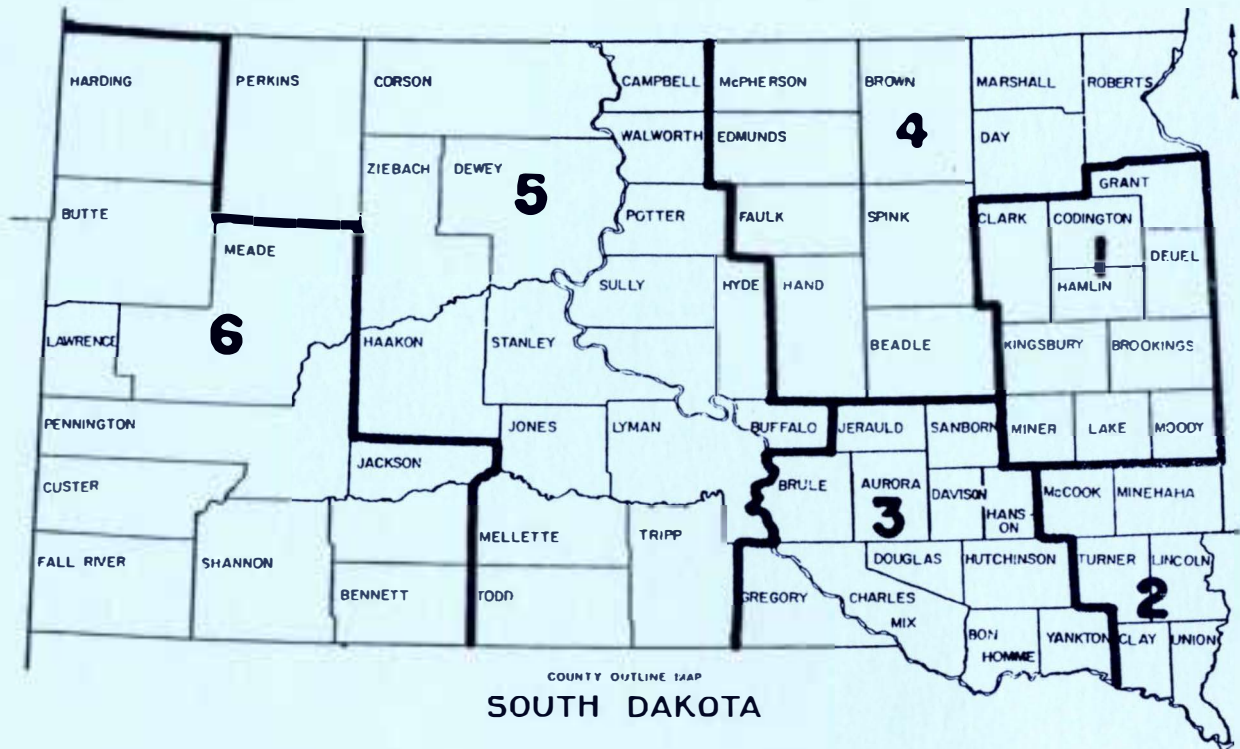
