The Three Factors of Demography



• Death

• Migration

We lack precise timely measurements of Migration

- Tax returns are consistent and timely
 - The problem is that not everyone files, and folks move from dependent to taxpayer status
- American Community Survey data is consistent and timely
 - The problem is that the survey methodology includes a high margin of error, and that increases in rural communities.
 - Another problem is that moving targets are more difficult to hit.
