Economic Momentum Index

• The Index measures momentum in a county (or Reservation) relative to the overall economic momentum of the state.

 Percentage changes in employment, population, and income in each county are normed to the state's average percentage change over the time period.

The Economic Skills Mismatch

 The gap between the qualifications an individuals possess and skills needed by the labor market

✓ Poor skills does not indicate poor education

Skill-Mismatch Index (SMI)

$$\mathbf{SMI}_{\text{sector}} = \sum_{j=1}^{3} (s_j - M_{ij})^2$$

Where:

j = Skill Level (1=High, 2=Semi, 3=Low).

 S_i = Percent of County Population with Skill Level j.

M_{ii} = Percent of Workers in Industry į with Skill Level j.

Industry Skill "demand" minus County Skill "supply"

Skills Mismatch Index (SMI) Key

SMI < 25 Best Skill Match

SMI; 25-50 Very Good Skill Match

SMI; 50-100 Fair Skill Match

SMI; 100-200 Poor Skill Match

SMI; 200-300 Very Poor Skill Match

SMI > 300 Worst Skill March

- Assumption: Any economic development in the Reservations is a result of federal funding.
 - While this may improve living standards, it does not provide maintainable economic development (Addressing the symptom not the problem)
