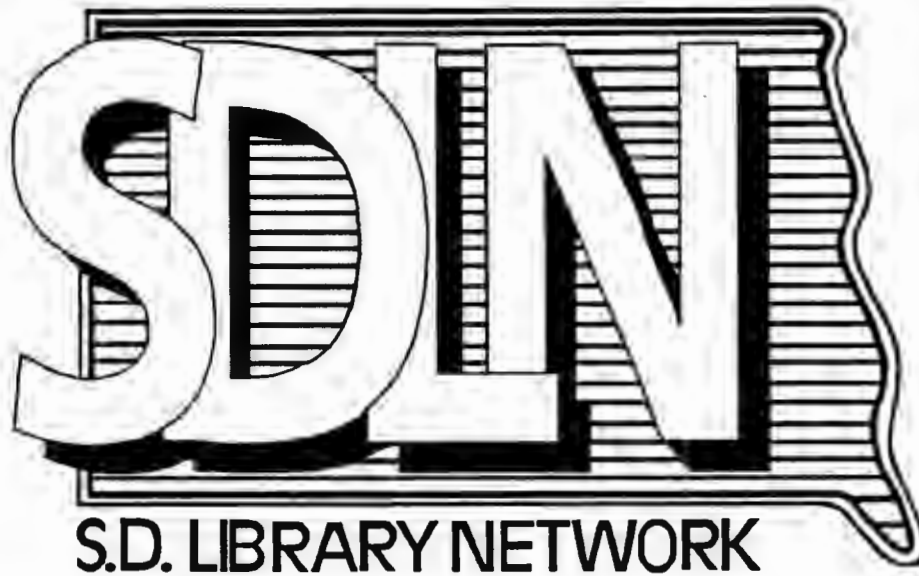

SDLN Highlights of 1993

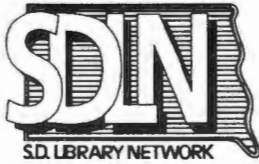
- SDLN Computer was upgraded to reduce user response time.
- Expanded staff duties in order to be more responsive to library needs.
- Advisory Council established an Executive Committee to manage the Network's regular operations.
- Averaged 1.6 million transactions per month.
- Database exceeded 2.3 million items.

If each SDLN item had an average of four entries (author, title, two subjects), the SDLN catalog would require 9.2 million cards to record all of those entries. Assuming that there are 96 catalog cards per inch and 15 inches per drawer, 1,440 cards will fit in a card catalog drawer. 9.2 million cards divided by 1,440 per drawer indicates that 6,398 drawers would be needed. Using counter-height 30-drawer cabinets, 213 cabinets would be needed. If each cabinet is 42 inches wide, the catalog would extend for 745 feet, or more than two and one-half football fields.
- Enrolled a total of 156 dial-up libraries.
- Beta tested dial access interlibrary loan so dial-up libraries may now electronically and instantly transmit their requests to the holding libraries.
- Added health index of over 190 journals to the PALS database.
- Instituted procedures to monitor database for more efficient operation, which resulted in improved response times, avoided "full" database files and assured available space for new records.

Future Plans

- Enhance dial access and continue to expand dial ILL usage.
- Enhance the SDLN communications network by:
 - Connecting to INTERNET
 - Replacing remote DCP's
 - Utilizing the state communications backbone to replace 9,600 baud lines
- Increase SDLN membership.
- Expand Reference Databases as resources permit, including community and state information.
- Add staff needed to expand network implementation, programming and deduplication services.
- Upgrade system to meet increasing usage needs and to expand services, including more mass storage, additional processor, an uninterruptable power supply and air conditioning.

The Network



The South Dakota Library Network (SDLN) is a statewide automated library system of 33 member libraries with more than two million items in its database. It was created by the State Library under South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) 14-1-48 to establish, maintain, and operate a computerized library network in order to promote statewide resource sharing among libraries and to increase access to libraries and information for South Dakota citizens.

Member libraries include public, school, hospital, governmental, and both private and public college and university libraries. SDLN is a comprehensive automated library system which allows libraries to search the holdings of all the member institutions, as well as to perform the basic library functions of circulation, acquisitions, controlling serials and inventory, and to facilitate interlibrary loans between institutions. In 1991, the SDLN was expanded to provide linkage to the libraries in the Minnesota State University System (MSUS), Traverse de Sioux (TDS) public library System in Minnesota and North Dakota's Online Dakota Information Network (ODIN).

The Vision*



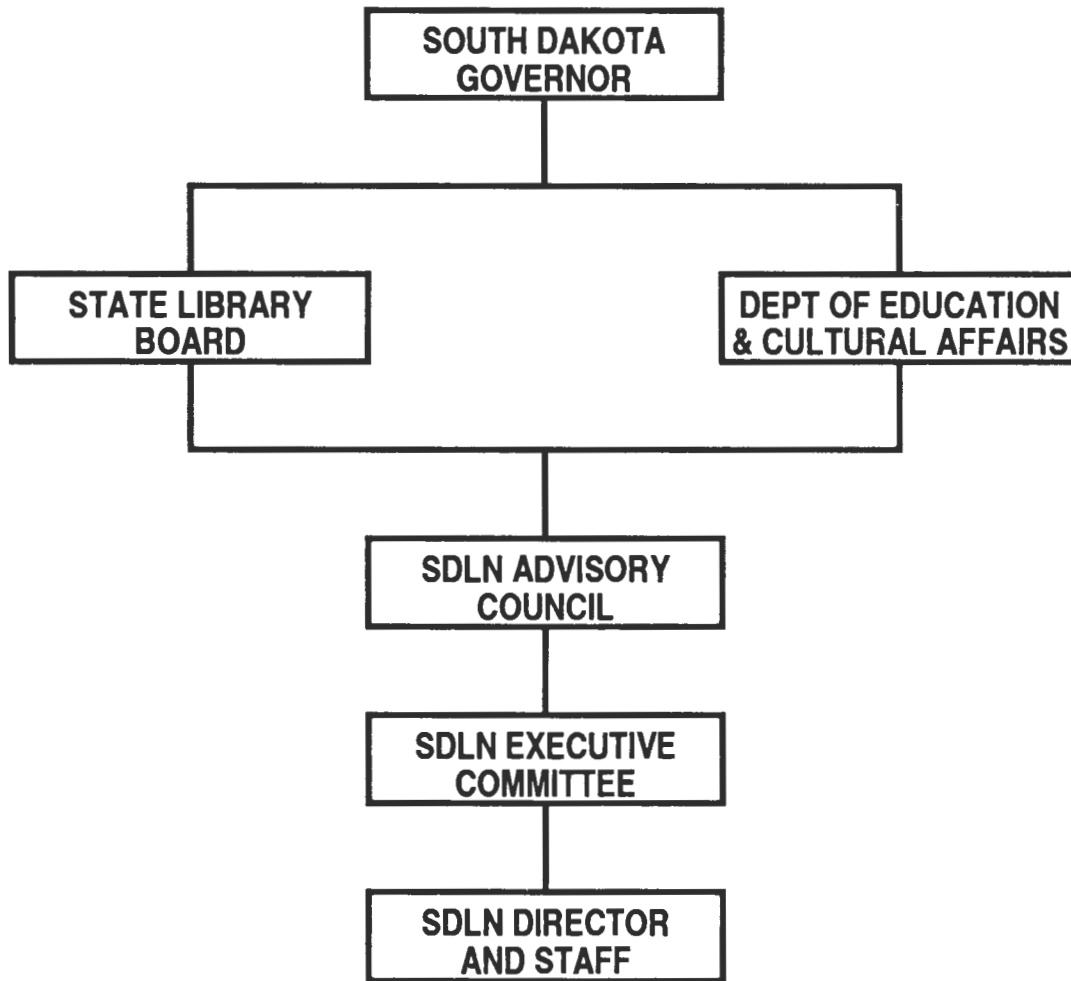
In the year 2000, the South Dakota Library Network (SDLN) will reach into every school, public, academic, and special library, and into every state and local government office in South Dakota. Electronic gateways will provide access by businesses and community organizations to SDLN. Network databases will be accessed via terminals in member libraries or dial-up modems and via Internet/NREN (the National Research Education Network). Internet/NREN gateways will allow users of SDLN to access other library catalogs worldwide. A sixth subsystem to permit online reference assistance will be added to the existing five -- the catalog, circulation, serials, interlibrary loan, and acquisitions. Additional databases (bibliographic, full-text, and multimedia) will be added to the options available on the online catalog. Shared collection development information will enable member libraries to maximize capital resources expenditures. Improved hardware and software will lead to the inclusion of digital audio and video image technology. SDLN will be linked using the high-speed fiber optic backbone of state, regional, and federal telecommunication networks.

As community networks evolve, SDLN will be utilized by people at home and on the move via computers, sophisticated televisions, and smart phones to create an information environment. This environment will not only supply needed information but will engage the person in learning. When fully evolved, this information environment will work on many levels, be multi-sensory, multi-modal, and capable of being personalized to the individual, to curriculum, or to business needs. In this environment, the library world will be part of a virtual world where learning is accomplished via simulation.

The South Dakota Library Network is both a backbone and a beginning to support the information services that will be demanded by the citizens of South Dakota in the future.

Governance and Administration



- The SDLN Advisory Council is made up of a representative from each member library, a representative of the dial access libraries, and a designee of the Executive Director of the Board of Regents.
- The SDLN Executive Committee includes: the State Librarian as Chair; the chair of the SDLN Advisory Council; a designee of the Executive Director of the Board of Regents; and four members elected by the Advisory Council.
- The SDLN director and staff are employees of the South Dakota Board of Regents and report to the Executive Director through the Director of Regents' Information Systems.
- Dynix, Inc. has a contract with SDLN for maintenance of the PALS software currently used by the network.

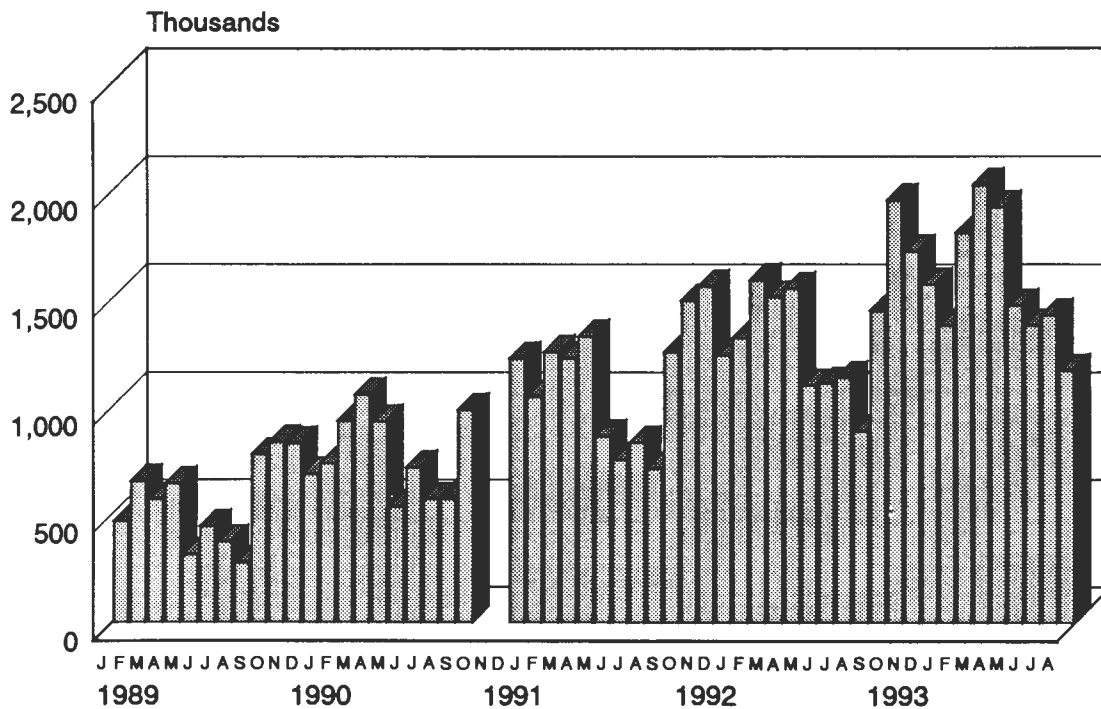

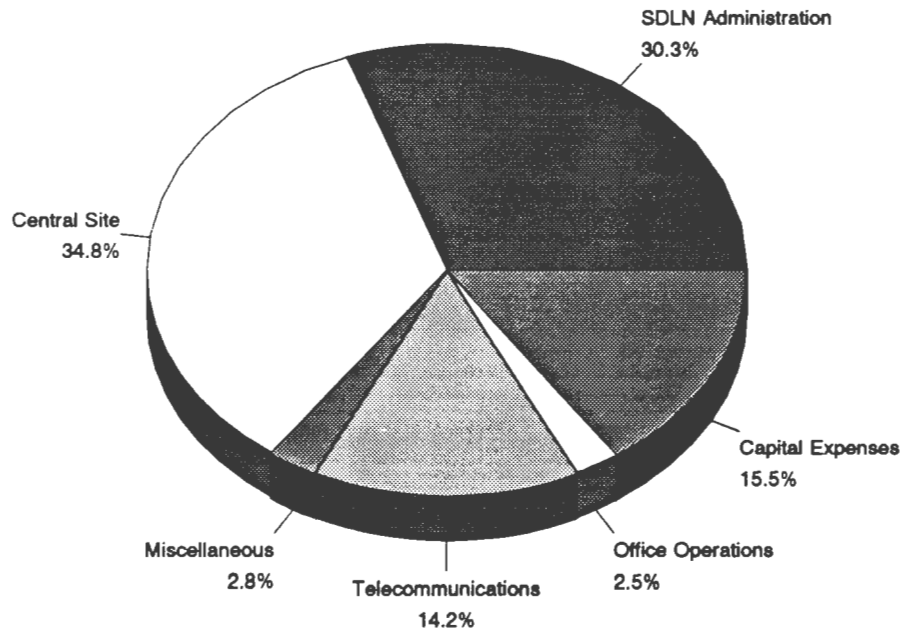

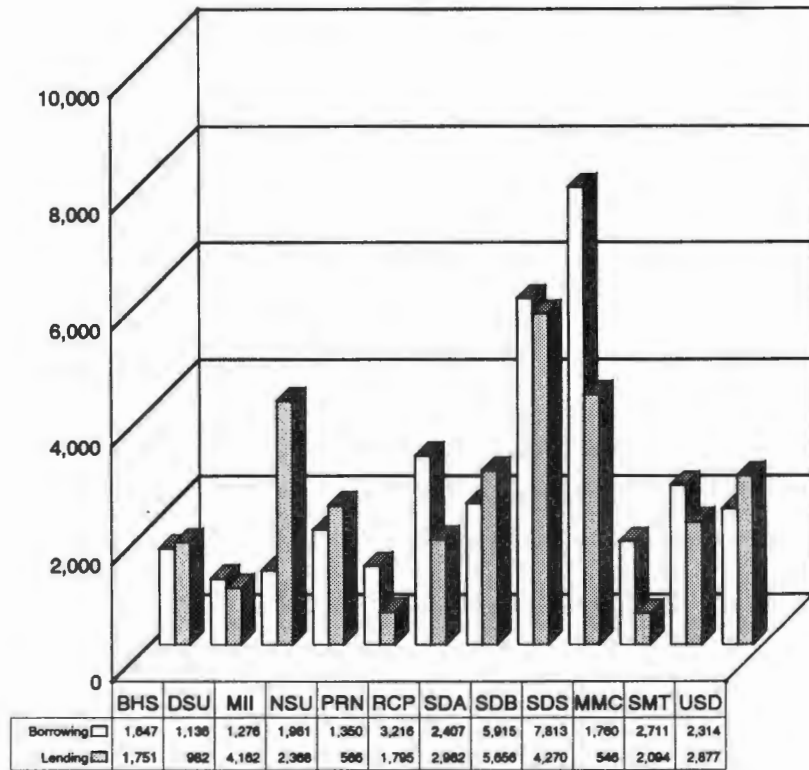
FY93 SDLN Interlibrary Loan Statistics

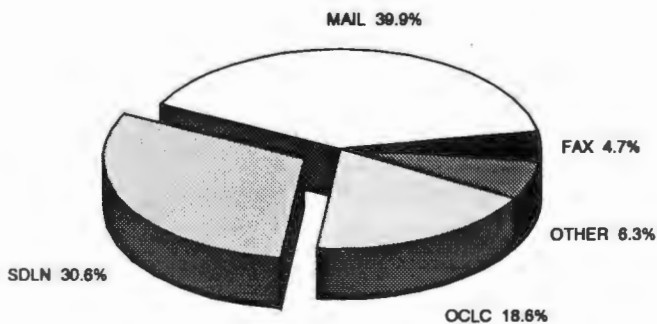

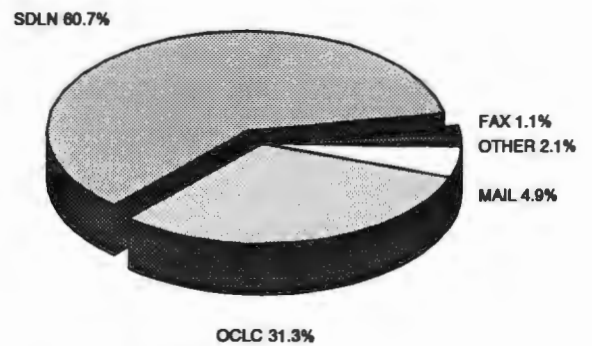
FY93 Statewide Lending Statistics

FY93 Statewide Borrowing Statistics

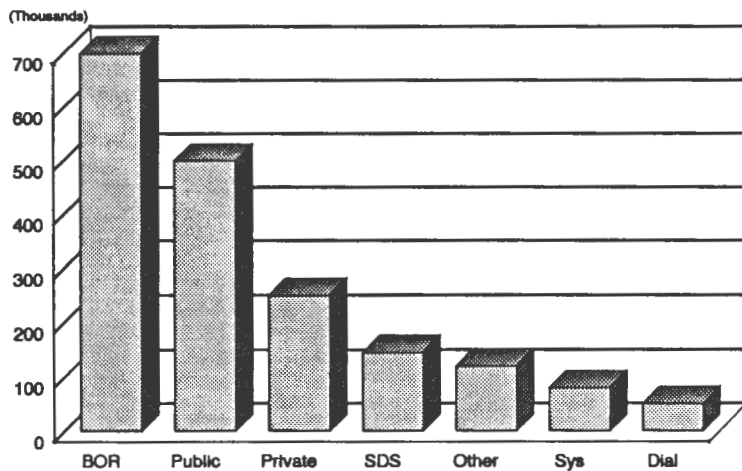

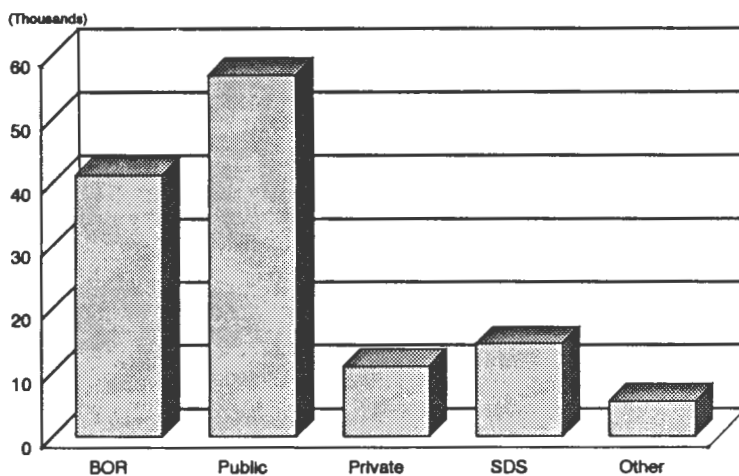
Transaction Statistics

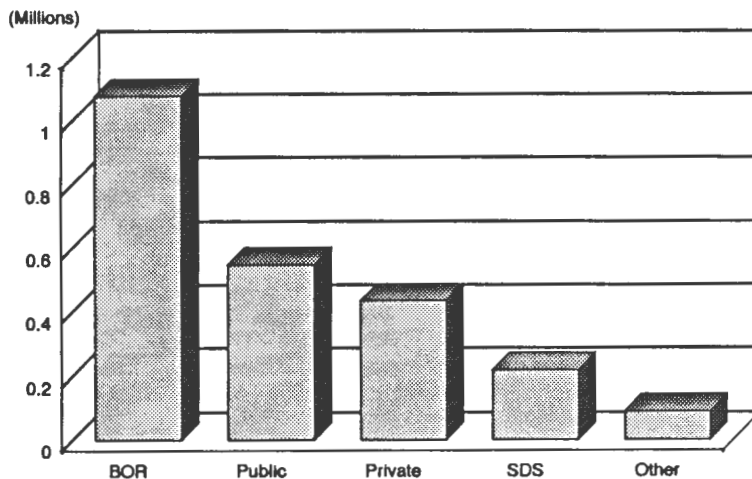
Patron Database Statistics
