



#### **Butte County Population Highlights**

- From 1990 to 2000, Butte County **gained 1,180 residents**, which was a **14.9%** increase in its total population.
- From 1990 to 2000, Butte County gained 800 residents to in-migration, which was a 10.1% increase in its total population.
- From the population pyramid, we can see that many residents aged 20-34 are leaving Butte County.
- 23.09% of Butte County's residents are under the age of 18, while 14.64% are aged 65+.
- Butte County's **median age is 38.0**. This is older than both Lawrence and Meade counties.
- Butte County's **sex ratio is 96.88**, meaning there are about 97 males for every 100 females. This is slightly higher than Lawrence, but lower than Meade.
- Butte County's fertility rate is 67.4 births for every 1,000 females aged 15-44. This is higher than Lawrence, but lower than Meade.

#### **Butte County Agriculture in 2002**

- Butte County had **639 farms**, which was a **7.2% increase** from 1997.
- Butte County's **average farm size is 1,976 acres**. This is larger than Lawrence, but smaller than Meade.
- Butte County's **average net farm income is \$24,805**. This is higher than both Lawrence and Meade counties.

#### **Butte County Economics in 2000**

- Butte County's **per capita income is \$13,997**. This is lower than both Lawrence and Meade counties.
- Butte County's **median household income is \$29,040**. This is lower than both Lawrence and Meade counties.
- 12.2% of Butte County's residents aged 25+ had received a B.S. degree or higher. This is lower than both Lawrence and Meade counties.
- 12.80% of Butte County's residents are living at or below the official poverty line. This compares with 14.75% for Lawrence County, and 9.39% for Meade County.
- **22.30%** of Butte County's **children under the age of 5** are living **at or below the official poverty line.** This compares with 27.37% for Lawrence County, and 14.47% for Meade County
- **10.0%** of workers in Butte County **commute from another county to work**. This is lower than both Lawrence and Meade counties.
