

Search for a new Integrated Library System

- o On October 22, 2002 upon recommendations from the SDLN users groups and the SDLN Executive Committee, the SDLN Advisory Council overwhelmingly selected ExLibris as the ILS vendor.
- o The SDLN contract team was selected, consisting of Warren Wilson (BOR/RIS), Phil Mulvaney (NSU), Beverly Lewis (RPL), Suzanne Miller (SDS), and Gary Johnson (SDLN). This team worked with ExLibris to negotiate contracts for Aleph (SDLN's future ILS), SFX, and MetaLib.
- o In May 2003, A contract for a new ILS was signed by Dr. Tad Perry, Executive Director of the South Dakota Board of Regents, and Oren Beit-Arie, Acting President of ExLibris USA.
- o The SDLN Project Team was selected, consisting of the SDLN functional user group chairs (Reference: Rise Smith (DSU), Catalogers: Joe Edelen (University of South Dakota), Circulation: Cindy Meinen (Mitchell Public Library), Interlibrary Loan: Jackie Hanson (Northern State University), Serials and Acquisitions: Carlene Aro (South Dakota State University - SDSU), and Government Documents: Patty Andersen (SD School of Mines and Technology)), and representatives from the test libraries. ExLibris requested that the test libraries be complex academic, public, and K12 libraries. Therefore, SDSU (representative: Bang Kim), Rapid City Public (representative: Ed Hughes), and Yankton High School (representative: Pat McDonald) were selected. Subsequently, in order to include a library with sublibraries, Northern State University together with the School for the Visually Impaired were added.
- o The project to migrate from PALS to Aleph began in May 2003 with a kickoff meeting in Spearfish. Presentations and planning information was given by Marina Spivakov, our ExLibris Project Manager.

New libraries were added to SDLN.

- o Little Wound High School was added as a new SDLN Associate member.
- o Wolsey School was added as a new SDLN Associate member.

The mission of the South Dakota Library Network is to enable all libraries in the State of South Dakota to provide its residents with the information they need, when they need it, and where they need it.

SDLN Membership Benefits

The South Dakota Library Network (SDLN) provides a seamless information structure publicly accessible to all residents of the state. SDLN librarians work collaboratively to align emerging technologies to leverage the state's existing library resources to meet patron needs. Over four million items and numerous electronic databases are available via SDLN, offering every South Dakota resident access to a growing body of resources, regardless of the location of the information or the resident. SDLN provides current information technologies, services, and resources that most South Dakota libraries would not be able to afford independently. SDLN is funded solely by member libraries cooperating to share resources among more than 200 school, public, private, academic, tribal, medical, government, and corporate libraries.

With SDLN membership, libraries receive the following benefits:

A single point of access showing the titles held by 70 individual South Dakota libraries.







South Dakota Library Network - Goals

- GOAL 1: The South Dakota Library Network will provide a basic set of information resources to every library in the state, regardless of size or type.
- GOAL 2: The South Dakota Library Network will facilitate the collaboration and cooperation of libraries of all types to form groups for the purpose of obtaining access to specialized information resources.
- GOAL 3: The South Dakota Library Network will provide an information structure to support seamless education from elementary through post-secondary.
- GOAL 4: The South Dakota Library Network will work to improve South Dakota libraries' ability to provide interlibrary loan of books, magazine articles, and other materials.
- GOAL 5: The South Dakota Library Network will expand and integrate access to high-quality, fee-based information services from commercial suppliers.
- GOAL 6: The South Dakota Library Network will leverage existing state resources and will comply with no less than the minimum state standards for information technology.

SDLN Membership Categories

The South Dakota Library Network (SDLN) is funded through membership fees paid by participating libraries. All membership fees are used to pay for the services provided for the libraries and their patrons. SDLN operates under SDCL 1-45-37 and a subsequent Memorandum of Understanding among the South Dakota Board of Regents, the South Dakota Department of Education and Cultural Affairs, and the South Dakota State Library Board. SDLN is a non-profit organization governed by a set of Guidelines (<http://www.sdln.net/about/memoguidelines.PDF>).

There are three types of membership in SDLN: Full, Associate, and Remote.

Full Member

Full Member libraries have access to all services and all library management modules of SDLN. The library management modules include the online catalog, cataloging (includes the MARC Editor), acquisitions, serials, interlibrary loan, and circulation (Inventory and Media Booking). Full Members have access to all reference databases, including full-text. Each Full Member library has a voting representative on the SDLN Advisory Council.

Associate Member

Associate Member libraries are configured in the online catalog and load their bibliographic records according to standards established by the Network. This membership category is designed to appeal to smaller libraries considering SDLN full membership. These members use the online catalog, cataloging (includes the MARC Editor), interlibrary loan, circulation (Inventory and Media Booking), and all reference databases (includes full-text). Only libraries with fewer than 30,000 titles are eligible for Associate Membership. Associate members elect two voting representatives from their numbers to serve on the governing SDLN Advisory Council.

A formula determines ongoing (annual) fees paid by Full and Associate Member libraries and is based upon the number of titles, volumes and patrons in that library, as well as annual usage. For a list of Full and Associate Member libraries, see pages 8-13.

There is also a one-time start-up fee paid by new member libraries (Full and Associate), which covers the implementation planning and setup for the new member library. This fee is based upon the number of branch libraries (or schools) and the estimated number of patrons, titles, and volumes in the library.


This start-up fee is:

\$500 per building with a library

\$0.015 per patron

\$0.035 per title

\$0.01 per volume



Remote Access Member

A Remote Access Member is also known as a "dial access" member. These members have access to the OPAC and Interlibrary Loan, but do not load their bibliographic records into the catalog. They currently have access to reference databases, including full-text, because of underwriting by the South Dakota State Library. Connection to SDLN will be by dial access or through an Internet Service Provider (ISP). Dedicated connections to SDLN or Internet access through SDLN are not available. Remote Access members elect a representative to the SDLN Advisory Council. For a list of current Remote Access Member libraries, see page 14. This membership category is designed for the library that wishes to participate in the information sharing activities of SDLN, but is fiscally unable to participate in the online catalog and circulation functions.

Sun Servers for the new Integrated Library System (ILS) Aleph.


SDLN User Groups 2003-2004


