SPECIAL EXHIBITIONS

The American Collection, December 2 - January 27, a selection from the Museum's collection, features paintings by Georgiana Kettler, Robert Mangold, Emily Martin, Brian Paulsen, Pablita Velarde, and Ulfert Wilke; prints by Thomas Hart Benton, Byron Burford, Marsden Hartley, Jan Kemerling, Rockwell Kent, Robert Nelson, and Stephen Poleskie; photographs by J.P. Atterberry and Judith Eastburn; and ceramics by Jerry Austin, John Glick, and Roy Strassberg.

Textiles from Vanishing Cultures, February 3 - 24, was curated by Valerie Justin, author of *Flat-Woven Rugs of the World*, and was organized for tour by Landau Exhibition Services of Los Angeles. The exhibition includes 30 vintage carpets, blankets, bags and other woven items from tribal people of Bolivia, Caucasus, Central Asia, Iran, Iraq, Mexico, Morocco, Romania, Tunisia, Turkey, United States, and Yugoslavia.

Special exhibitions at the Museum this season are supported by Gerald and

Olive Brown of San Diego, California; Dakota Granite Company of Milbank; Friends of the Arts in Brookings; the Institute of Museum Services, an independent federal agency; and the South Dakota Arts Council, a state agency with funds from the State Legislature and National Endowment for the Arts.

Ongoing exhibitions from the Museum collections are *Harvey Dunn Paintings*, *Oscar Howe Paintings*, *Marghab Linens*, *Native American Art*, and *The South Dakota Collection*.

MUSEUM RECEIVES YEAR OF RECONCILIATION AWARD

On the recommendation of the South Dakota Council for the Year of Reconciliation, Governor George S. Mickelson presented a Certificate of Recognition to the Museum for its contributions toward better understanding among the races in South Dakota through the touring exhibition, *Lakota Art Treasures*.

The exhibition, which has shown in Brookings, Sioux Falls, and Vermillion, was organized from the Frank and Anna Dudeck, Beatrice

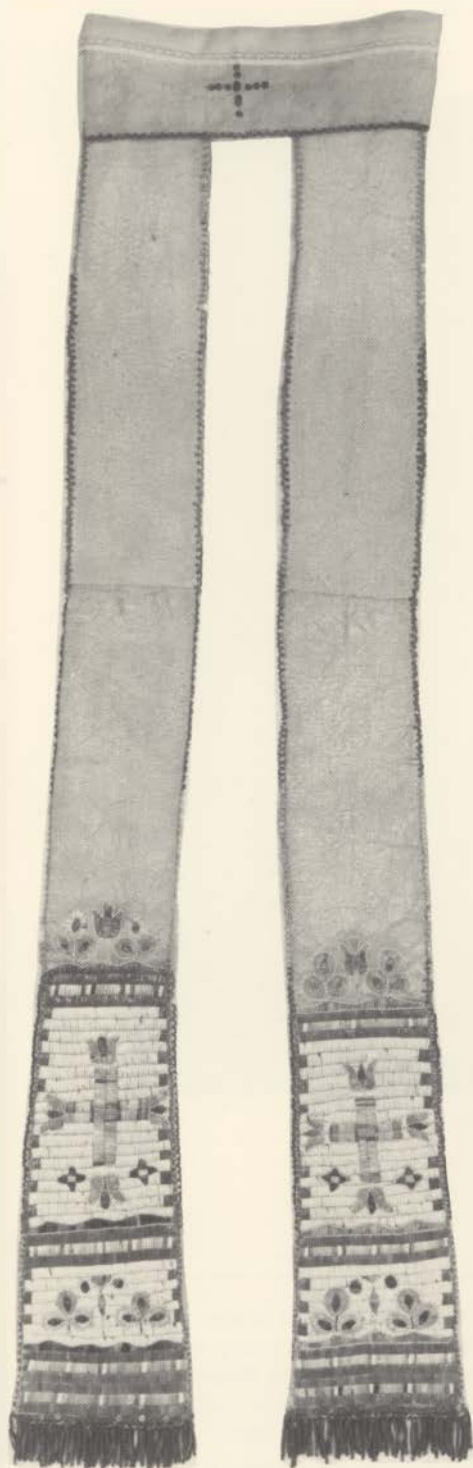
Medicine, Ben Reifel, Harold Shunk, Frank and Abigale Thorburn, Albert Wentzy, and Claude Whitlock collections at the Museum, and was designed to show Lakota or Western Sioux cultural values through such works of art as pipes used in prayer, rattles used in healing ceremonies, and flutes used in courtship.

Many of the articles are now on display at the Museum, and a smaller version of the exhibition will continue on tour in South Dakota during 1991.

MUSEUM ACQUIRES ITS 94TH WORK BY HARVEY DUNN

Caroline Dunn Fischer, granddaughter of Harvey Dunn's brother Roy, and her husband Alan have given Dunn's 1905 painting, "After the Rain," to the Museum. The oil was painted at Chadds Ford, Pennsylvania, while Dunn was a student of Howard Pyle. Pyle's school was a few miles away in Wilmington, Delaware, and he often took students to Chadds Ford to paint the historic Brandywine River valley.

They used the old grist mill in Chadds Ford—now the Brandywine River Museum—as a studio in inclement weather. The Fischers live in Littleton, a suburb of Denver, and were urged to give the painting to the Denver Art Museum. They decided to visit South Dakota first, however, and that visit convinced them to give it to the South Dakota Art Museum. It is the earliest oil painting in the Dunn Collection.

Mrs. White Eagle of Wakpala, South Dakota, made this stole for her adoptive son, Rev. Frank M. Thorburn of Brookings. The design in the quillwork is the Episcopalians' Niobrara Cross, which has pasque flowers at the ends of the post and beam.

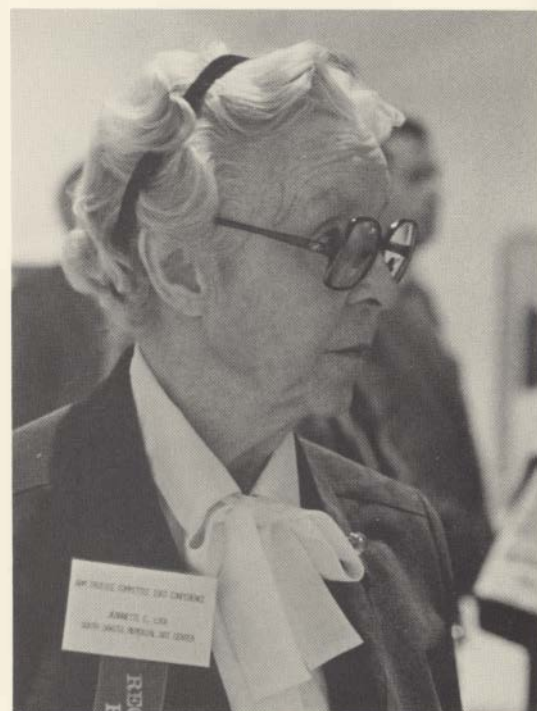


Supreme Court with mural by Charles Holloway, South Dakota State Capitol, Pierre, from *Renaissance on the Missouri*.

Phyllis Bartling, Cecelia Beirne, Margy Chamberlin, Mildred Gastler, Dee Kirkbride, Elaine Olson, Cookie Perkins, Kay Romans, Larry Stine, Helen Walters, Avis Wilson, and Beryl Younger participated in the Museum's Fall 1990 Docent Training Program and were successful in the examination to qualify as docents or increase their docent rank. Margy Chamberlin, Mildred Gastler, and Dee Kirkbride are new docents, and Phyllis Bartling is the most seasoned veteran of the group with the rank of Docent X. She shares that honor with Naomi Gilkerson. All are members of the Museum Guild and all are from Brookings. Docents are responsible for guiding tours of Museum exhibitions and for presenting programs on the Museum's collections in local schools.

L.T. Vern Laustsen, a charter member of the Museum Board of Trustees and its president during 1980-82, died August 20 in Aberdeen, South Dakota. He was 68. Laustsen was born 1921 in Beresford, South Dakota, and attended South Dakota State

FILMS

University before entering the Navy in World War II. After the war he married Gwyn LePoidevin of Racine, Wisconsin, and earned a degree in agriculture at Purdue University. He became general manager of the Dakota Farmer Company in Aberdeen in 1960 and later became its owner. It became the Dakota-North Plains Company, a part of which was the North Plains Press. In 1970 Laustsen published Robert Karolevitz's biography of Harvey Dunn, *Where Your Heart Is*, which won the Wrangler Award from the National Cowboy Hall of Fame. Much of the publishing enterprise is now in the hands of Vern's daughter, Judith Gruebele. Laustsen was recognized for his contributions to South Dakota art by the Museum Board in 1987 with its Artistic Achievement Citation.

Jeannette Lusk of Huron, South Dakota, a charter member of the Museum Board and its first president during 1969-75, received the fourth annual Spirit of Dakota Award from Linda Mickelson, wife of Governor George S. Mickelson, at a ceremony in Huron on October 7. The award was in recognition for Lusk's leadership, success, and status in the state. The daughter of Governor Coe Crawford, she was appointed by Governor Nils Boe to the first South Dakota Arts Council in 1966, received the Governor's Award in the Arts from Governor Richard Kneip in 1973, and was named Life Member of the South Dakota Art Museum Board in 1985.

MUSEUM RECEIVES STATE AND FEDERAL SUPPORT

General Operating Support Grants of \$20,712 from the Institute of Museum Services, an independent federal agency, and \$12,381 from the South Dakota Arts Council, a state agency with funding from the Legislature and National Endowment for the Arts, have been awarded to the Museum for its 1990-91 season.

Films are free to the public and begin at 7:30 p.m.

Wings of Desire, December 13. The Magic Christian, January 17. In this 1970 film directed by Joseph

McGrath, Sir Guy Grand (Peter Sellers), the richest man in the world and a grand guy, and his adopted son (Ringo Starr) set out to see how far people will go for money. English dialogue.

The Milky Way, February 21. Luis Bunuel's 1969 film is about two unlikely pilgrims (Paul Frankeur and Laurent Terzieff), who meet, among others, the Devil and the Marquis de Sade during their odyssey through time. French with English subtitles.
