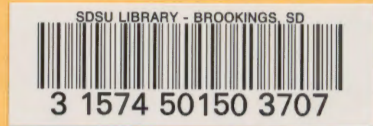

# NOXIOUS WEED CONTROL CALENDAR



## Dates to complete 2,4-D spraying

- May 5-20—Hoary Cress
- May 15-31—Leafy Spurge, Russian Knapweed
- May 15-31—Biennial Thistles, Wormwood Sage, Goldenrod
- June 1-15—Canada Thistle, Perennial Sow Thistle, Field Bindweed
- June 1-20—Gumweed
- July-Sept—Respray or cultivate after harvest
- Aug-Sept—Retreat perennials in grass

## Semi-Selective Herbicides



- April-May
- or (*Tordon, Fenac, Trysben, Banvel*)
- Sept-Oct

## Non-Selective Herbicide (*Roundup*)

- June-Oct—Quackgrass (over 8 in. high)
- Sept-Oct—Canada Thistle (10 in. - bloom)
- Sept-Oct—Field Bindweed (bloom)
