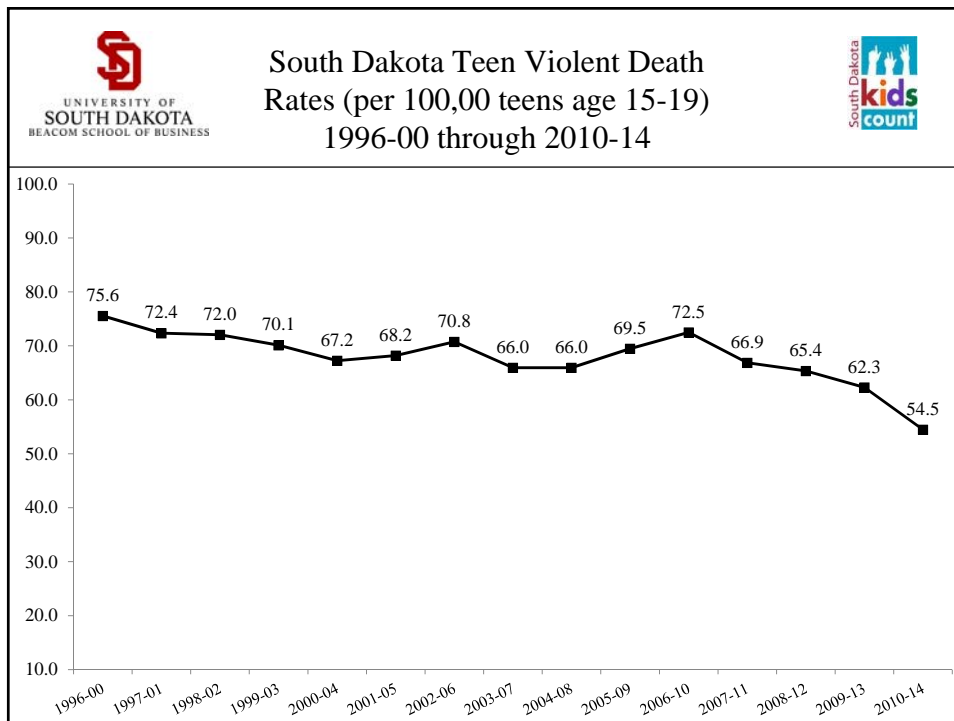
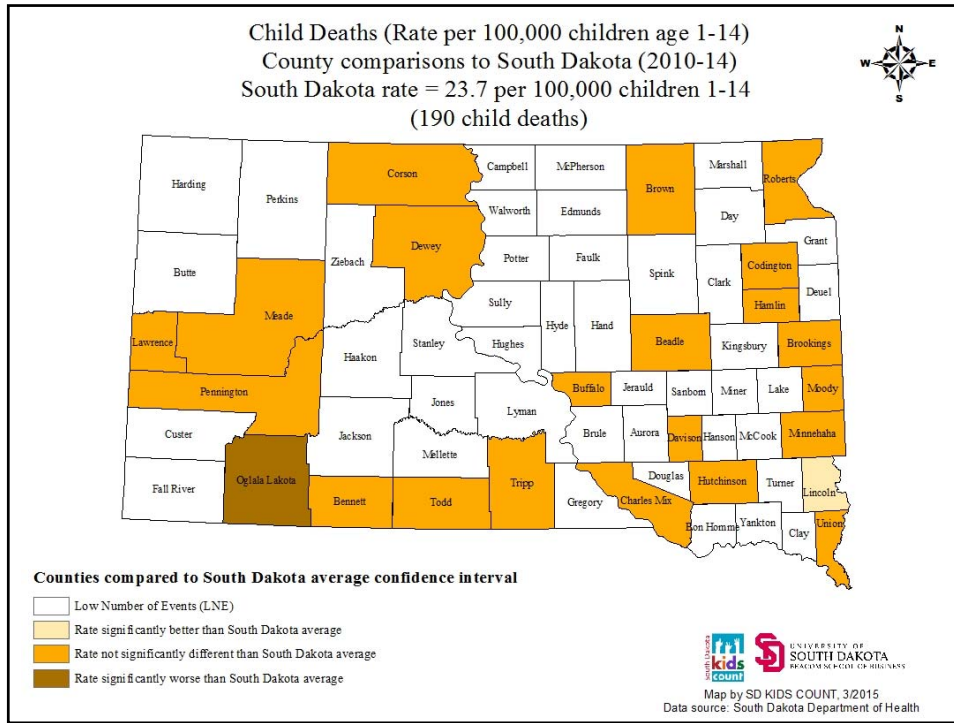





Child Deaths by Race 2010-14

Other Races.....	13.8



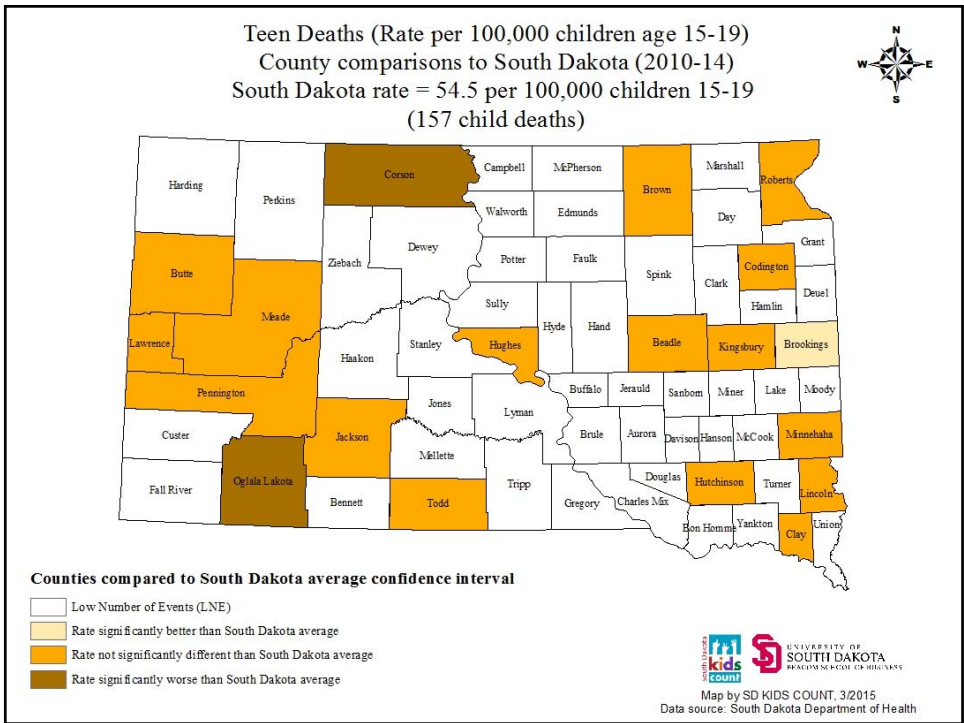


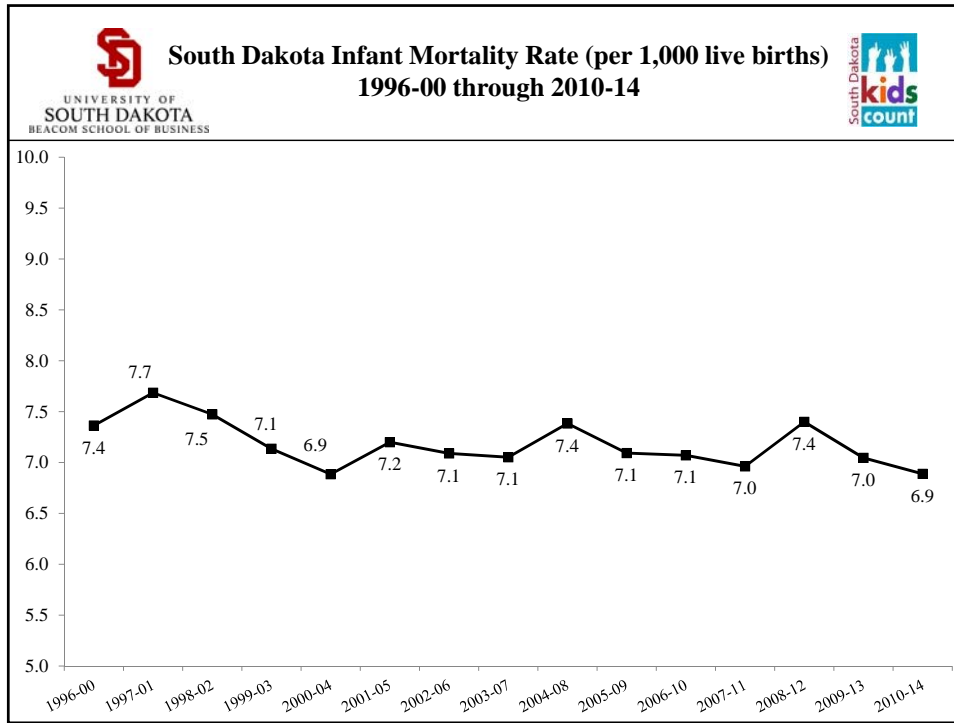
Teen Deaths by Race 2010-14

2010-14**

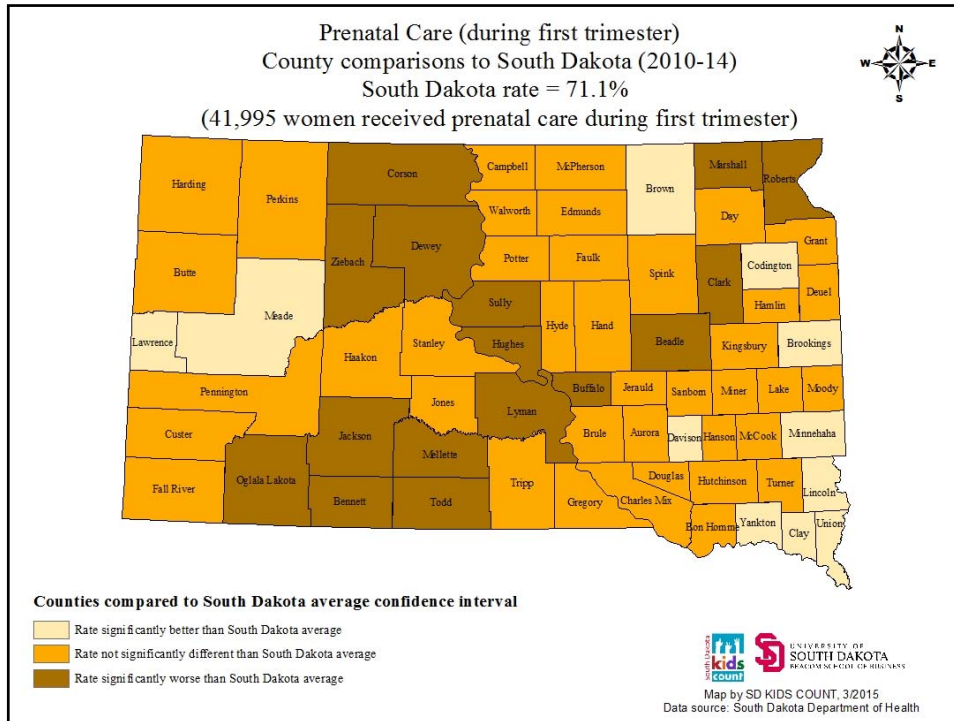
