































Child Deaths by Race 2010-14



Child Deaths (deaths per 100,000 children ages 1-14)









Teen Deaths by Race 2010-14



Teen Violent Deaths (deaths per 100,000 teens ages 15-19)









Infant Mortality by Race 2010-14

Other Races	12.9









Births to Single Teens by Race 2010-14



Births to Single Teens (girls under age 20)








Prenatal Care by Race 2010-14
