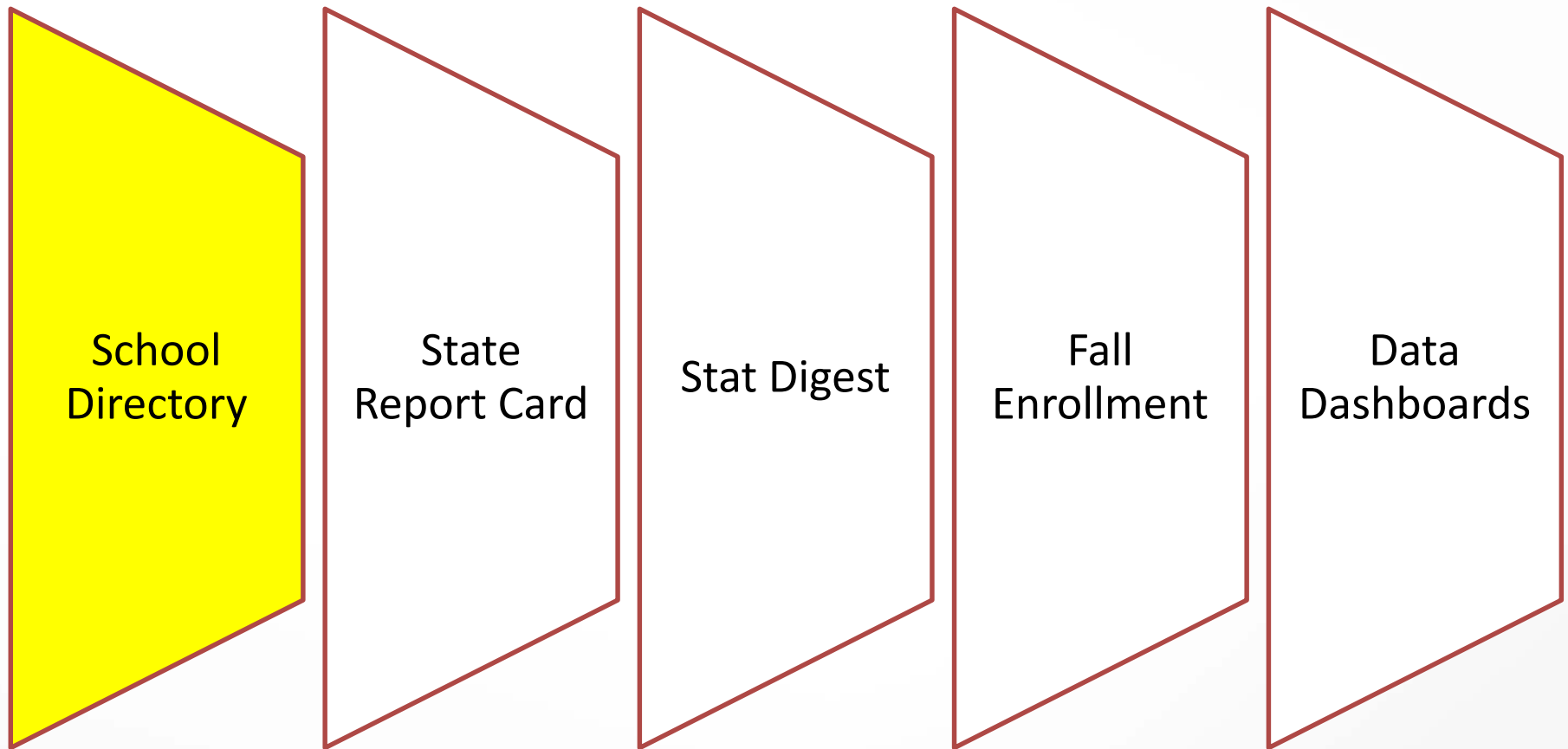



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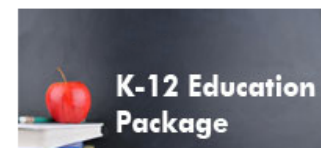

### 2016-2017 School Performance Index and Accountability Report Card

### The SPI

South Dakota's accountability system is based on a 100-point School Performance Index (SPI). The SPI consists of three key indicators, with a numeric value assigned to each of the indicators, to measure a school's performance. These values are added to create a total SPI score out of 100 points. The SPI recognizes both achievement and growth, while providing schools with unique student achievement targets that encourage continuous and ongoing improvement. This year's system, the last under the state's No Child Left Behind Flexibility Waiver, is similar to the information reported for 2015-16 on how students can demonstrate they are on track to becoming college, career, and life ready.

The accountability system incorporates three key indicators of school performance, described below.

Although the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) was signed into law on December 10, 2015 and replaces the No Child Left Behind Act, all states including South Dakota remain under their previous accountability systems for this school year. 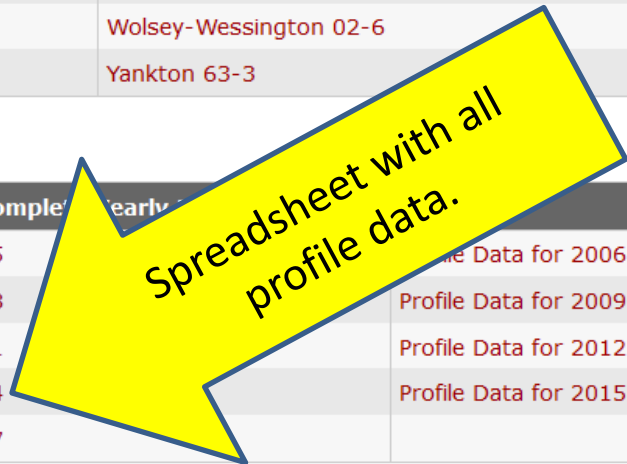

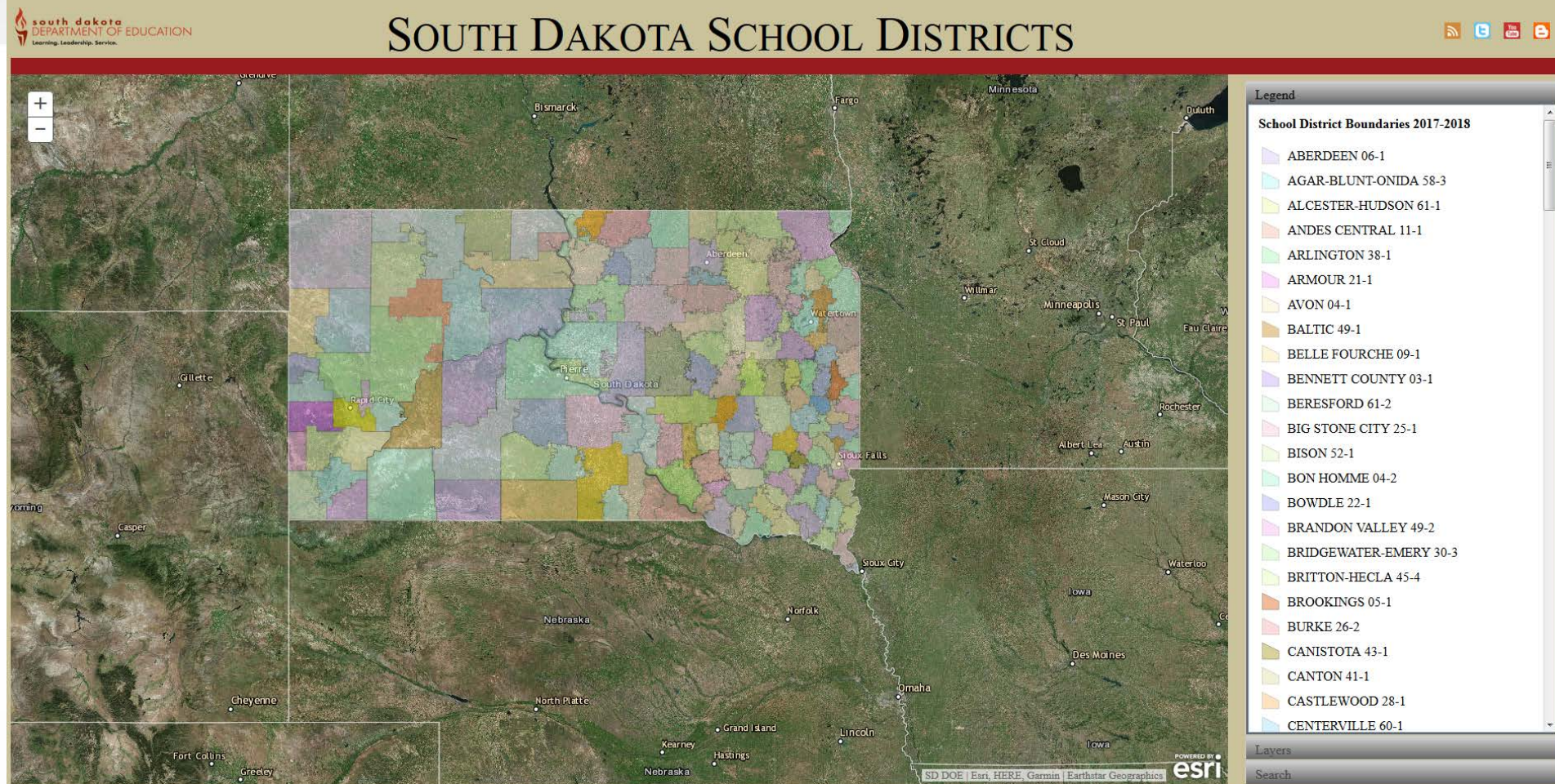

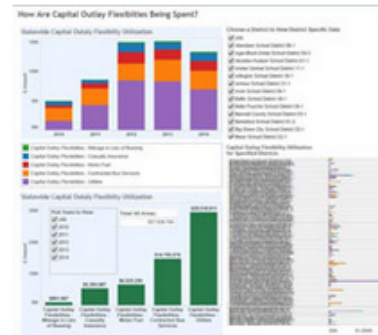

### How Are Capital Outlay Flexibilities Being Spent?



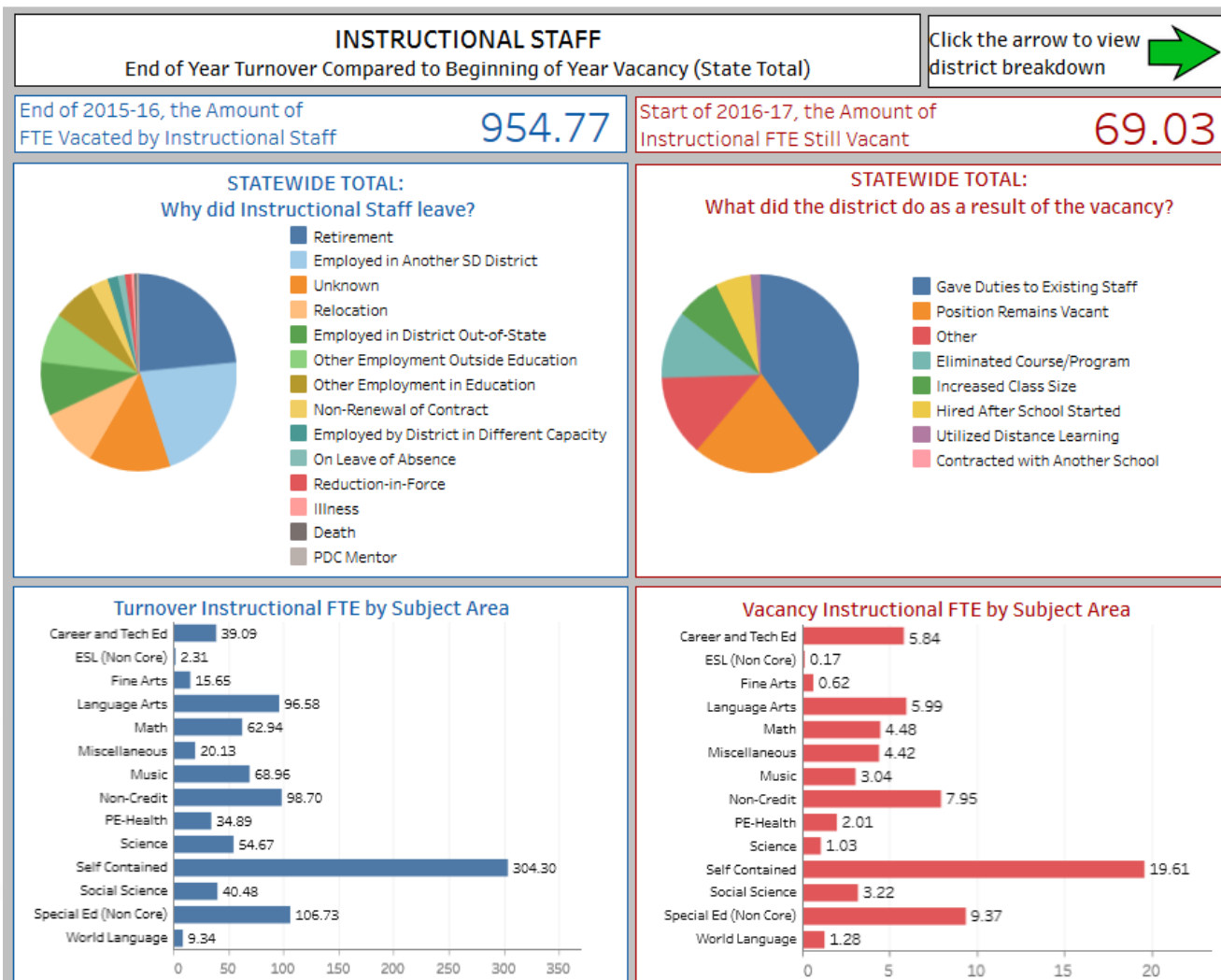
### Utilization of Capital Outlay Flexibilities and Change in General Fund Balances

When completing the Data Request form, you must be very specific so that we can provide you with the data you are requesting. Please note that all cells with less than 10 students will be suppressed to protect the student's privacy.

Pursuant to SDCL Chapter 1-27, if there are costs involved in the fulfillment of your data request, the Department of Education will provide you with a time/cost estimate prior to moving forward with the data request.

Those individuals seeking data for research purposes must meet the following criteria:

1. The research aligns with the South Dakota Department of Education's goals and objectives and approval of the Department.
2. Researchers must complete the Data Request form and are subject to the same cost requirements as stated above.
3. Researchers must provide verification of their approval under an Institutional Review Board (IRB).
4. The conditions in FERPA regulation 34 CFR 99.31(a) (6) are met.
5. A Data Sharing Agreement is signed to ensure compliance with FERPA regulations and DOE policies.
6. Researcher agrees to return or destroy education records at completion of research use.
7. Researcher understands associated penalties for violation of data privacy, use or re-disclosure.

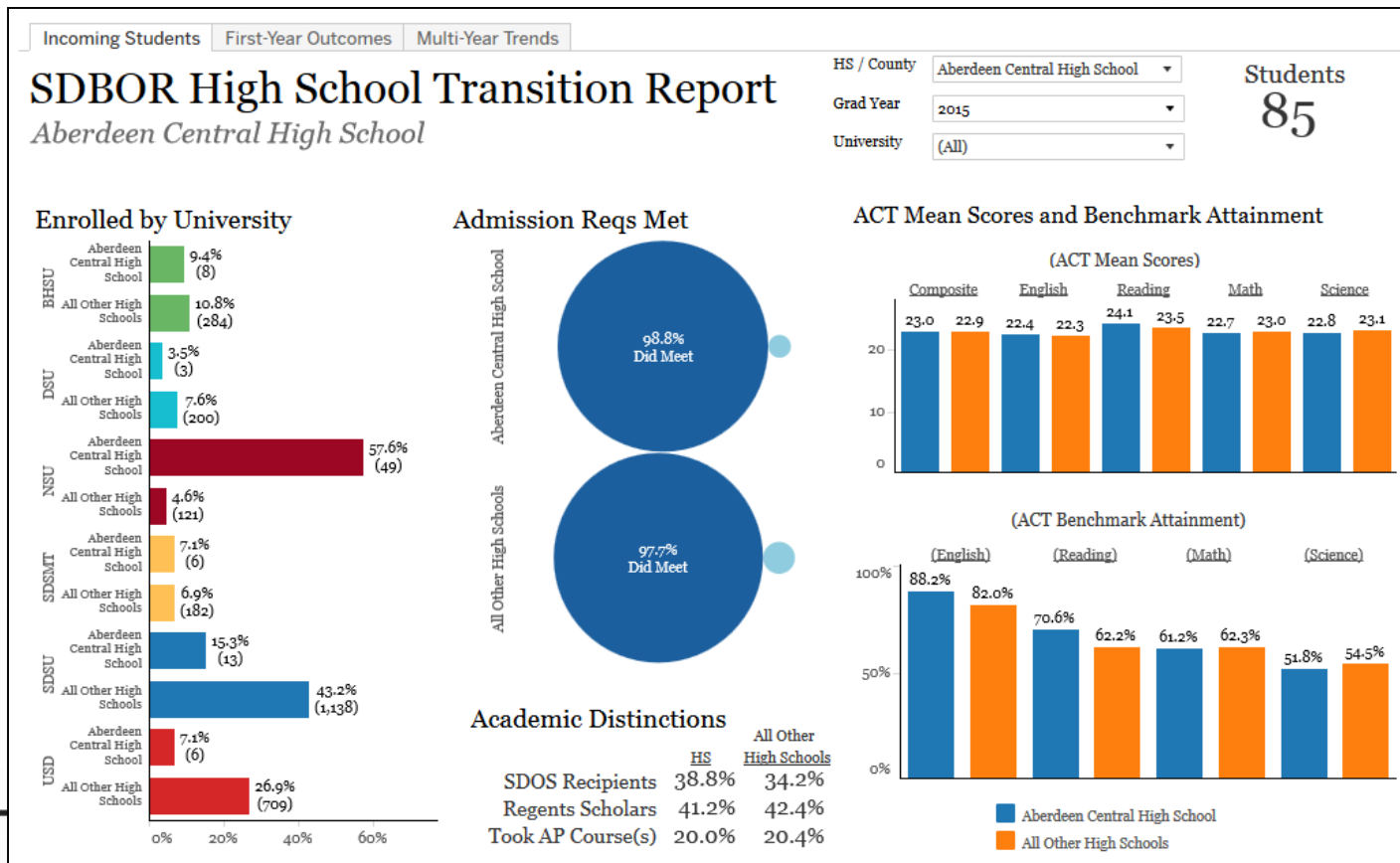


# OTHER EDUCATIONAL DATA

- USED is a source for much educational data
  - States report aggregated data to the federal government using *EdFacts*. Multiple files are submitted throughout the year. Much of the data supplied in *EdFacts* is used in NCES/IES research and USED monitoring.
  - USED also administers the NAEP assessment, which is given to a sampling of 4<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders.
