### Census Business Builder

- Bring together demographic and economic data
- A portrait of both the consumer and economic environments
- Provide guidance to opening a new business or adding to an existing one
- Released on September 9, 2015



## Key Features

- Select the type of business and potential location
- An interactive map that allows selection of the area and comparisons to neighboring areas
- Downloadable and printable reports (including trend charts)



## Industries (total=49)

- Construction: Electrical, flooring, painting and plumbing contractors.
- Food services: Caterers, drinking places, restaurants and fast food.
- Health care: Chiropractors, dentists, doctors, therapists and optometrists.
- Personal services: Auto repair, beauty salon, daycare, landscaping, taxi services, travel agencies.
- Professional services: Accountants, consultants, insurance agents, lawyers and real estate agents.
- Retail: Liquor stores, convenience stores, florists, gas stations and used-car dealers.

  - Spending on dining out; entertainment/recreation; financial services; health care; household services, housing, personal care, transportation, and travel
