


The Federal Reserve System

- The USA's central bank
- Responsibilities:
 - Supervision and regulation
 - Payments system
 - Monetary policy
- Structure
 - Board of Governors in Washington, DC
 - 12 Reserve Banks around the country

What is monetary policy?

- Simple answer: setting interest rates
- Not-so-simple answer: buying and selling government bonds to influence the general level of interest rates



The Federal Reserve's monetary policy goals

- **Dual mandate** specified by Congress
- Stable prices
 - 2% inflation according to PCE index
 - Inflation includes *all* goods and services
- Maximum employment
 - Harder to quantify



Overview of economic conditions

U.S.

- Continued moderate output growth
- Rapidly improving labor markets in 2014; somewhat slower so far in 2015
- Inflation persistently below FOMC target


Regionally

- Low, but a recent rise in SD unemployment; labor market still improving on other margins
- Slowing output growth in SD and Rapid City

12-month percent change



2009 US dollars



Unemployment rate




U.S. unemployment rate by education, age 25+

What about labor force participation?


unemployment = $\frac{job seekers}{job seekers + employed}$

Labor force participation rate Percent



Percent



Percent, 12-month moving average



Percent, 12-month moving average



1-year percent change; private industry



12-month percent change



- FOMC will assess realized and expected progress on inflation and employment


Balance sheet

Percent



Trillions


