INTRODUCTION

This publication is the second in a series of reports on South Dakota's 1970 population. The first was Agricultural Experiment Station Bulletin 580, South Dakota Population and Net Migration 1960-1970 (February 1971). The third report will examine changes in the age and sex structure of South Dakota's population. The fourth publication will update the 1962 source book, Circular 151, South Dakota Population and Farm Census Facts. The fifth publication is to analyze the relationship between changing fertility patterns and South Dakota's population.

The tables in this report have been assembled to provide a convenient source of population information for the counties and incorporated places of South Dakota. The basic data were taken from the U.S. Bureau of the Census, 1970 Census of Population, Advance Report, South Dakota PC(VI)-43, November 1970. The figures are final population counts, although the Bureau plans to correct a few minor errors prior to the publication of the Final Report series for South Dakota. The corrected total for the State is 666,257, whereas the county populations in

these tables total 665,507, or 750 less. This difference is due to the under-reporting of the 1970 population for the State of South Dakota by 750 (Hamlin, and Meade Counties: 348 and 402 respectively). The tables in this report have been adjusted to compensate for these errors in reporting. The figure for the town of Estelline, Hamlin County, was adjusted from 276 to the correct figure of 624.

The organization of this report is as follows:

Counties

Three tables present data for South Dakota's 67 counties.

Table 1. Number of inhabitants in 1950, 1960 and 1970 of South Dakota's counties arranged alphabetically. The last two columns give the percent change 1950-60 and 1960-70.

Table 2. South Dakota counties ranked by population size in 1970 and 1960.

Table 3. South Dakota counties ranked by percent change 1960-70 and 1950-60.

Incorporated Places

The U.S. Bureau of the Census reported 307 incorporated places in South Dakota in 1970. Between 1960 and 1970 two places were incorporated and reported: Box Elder (Pennington County) and Dimock (Hutchinson County). Not included in the tables is the town of Batesland (Shannon County) incorporated in 1969. Prior to the revision notification, the population of 135 reported for Batesland by the Bureau of the Census was included in the total population of 3034 listed for the Unorganized Territory of East Shannon County. These centers have zeros recorded for population in 1950 and 1960 along with corresponding percent change figures in Tables 4, 5 and 7. Similarly, places first appearing in 1960, Artas (Campbell County), Kranzberg (Codington County) and North Sioux City (Union County), have zeros for 1950 population and 1950-1960 percent change. Two communities were listed as incorporated places by the Census in 1950 and 1960 but not in 1970. They are Meckling (Clay County) and Newark (Marshall County), neither of which is included in these tables. Buffalo, Shannon and Washabaugh Counties had no incorporated places in 1970.

Four tables present the data for the incorporated places in South Dakota.

Table 4. Places arranged alphabetically with populations in 1950, 1960 and 1970 and percent change 1950-60 and 1960-70. Also included are county or counties in which each place is located. Thus by referring to the alphabetical listing of Table 4 any place of interest in the counties can be identified in Tables 5 and 6.

Table 5. Incorporated centers ranked by size in 1960 and 1970.

Table 6. Incorporated centers ranked by percent change 1960-70 and 1950-60. The 2 new places in 1970 are not included in the table, whereas those first appearing in 1960 are given zero ranks in the 1950-60 column.

Table 7. Places listed by counties. Counties are ordered alphabetically, and incorporated centers are listed in alphabetical order within counties. Places in two counties (see Table 4) are listed in the county which had the largest portion of their population as of 1960. Population totals and percent change 1950-60 are given for each county as well as for each place. Buffalo, Shannon and Washabaugh Counties are not included, as they have no incorporated centers.
